of the Branch a ballot paper

Module Rule reference (if any) 16.2.1 On or before the opening day of the ballot the

> returning officer shall forward ballot material in a sealed envelope by prepaid post to each person on the roll of

voters at the address shown on the roll of voters.

Recommendation Increase the period the ballot is open to a minimum

> of 35 or 42 days to allow for additional time for members to receive and return the ballot material as members may be absent from home for extended

periods of time while working on board ships.

At present if a declaration envelope containing ballot papers was returned before the ballot opened it would need to be rejected as it was received before the ballot

opened.
