Casual Vacancy Election

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for:

Queensland Branch

- Ordinary Member of the Federal Council (1)

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 11/11/2024.

Each nomination shall be in writing, signed by the nominee and proposer and seconder, all of whom shall be financial members of the Branch.

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status, and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 23/12/2024.**

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a **PDF** file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

The subject line of your email should include the reference: E2024/149 - nomination (*your name*)

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. *It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.*
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
3. You may call 03 9285 7111 to enquire about the status of your nomination.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm midday (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 23/12/2024 can be accepted.

Each candidate may submit a candidate statement, **not exceeding 300 words in Microsoft Word (docx) format**, for inclusion with their ballot paper, should such ballot be held. The candidate statement shall be forwarded to and, received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm midday AEDT on 23/12/2024.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 20/01/2025 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 03/03/2025. A postal vote pack will be mailed to eligible voters on 20/01/2025.

Replacement Voter Pack

If the postal vote pack is not received by 30/01/2025 voters may contact the AEC to request a replacement voter pack by calling 02 9375 6366 or 03 9285 7111 or by sending email to IEBevents@aec.gov.au .

If you are on the roll of voters, a replacement ballot pack will be sent by regular mail.

Scrutineers

A candidate may appoint a member who is not a candidate for election to be a scrutineer on the candidate's behalf. Such scrutineer shall be appointed only with the scrutineer's consent in writing which shall be given to the Returning Officer not later than 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 03/03/2025.

The appointment of scrutineers opens 11/11/2024.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
