Scheduled Election

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for:

- **President (1)**
- **Treasurer (1)**
- **Ordinary Member of Federal Council (2)**

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 01/02/2021.

A nomination form is available for electronic completion on the AEC Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/. However, the nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) **on** 15/03/2021.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Portal: Australian Electoral Commission Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 15/03/2021.

Candidate Statements

Under Rule 33B (xv) of the Organisation, candidates may submit a resume not exceeding 300 words, for inclusion with the ballot paper. The resumes must be submitted not later than 12:00pm (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 15/03/2021. Resume should be submitted in Word document format and emailed to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au. Note that, emails greater than 6 MB may not be accepted by the AEC's firewall.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 12/04/2021 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 24/05/2021.

Scrutineers

According to Rule 33B (x) of the Organisation, the Returning Officer is to be informed about the appointment of the scrutineer in writing before the close of ballot period.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
