**Candidate Statements**

Candidates may submit a statement **not exceeding 300 words** in Microsoft Word (.docx) format to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the rules and are received by the Returning Officer by **5pm AEST on 03 August 2026** can be accepted.

**Voting Period**

The ballot, *if required*, will open on **24 August 2026** and close at **10am AEDT on 05 October 2026**.

**Scrutineers**

A candidate may appoint a member who is not a candidate for election to be a scrutineer on the candidate's behalf. The appointment of scrutineers closes **10am AEDT on 05 October 2026**. A Scrutineer Appointment form is available from the Returning Officer.
